CEO Message

HCE has focused on preventive maintenance and pole change outs which have proven to be very effective in limiting our outages. We continue to strive for reliable and affordable energy.

WAPA and Basin, our electric generation

providers, have both told us that HCE should expect increases to cost of power over the years to come. The financial pressures exerted by this rising cost of power continue to go up for HCE.

When HCE was first informed of our expected energy generation increase, it was supposed to be approximately 8% over three years. Now we have been informed that the cost impact on our cooperative is expected to average a 7% increase per year. The new kWh rate for each class of service at HCE will go into effect June 1, 2025. The new rate for irrigation accounts will go into effect on April 1, 2025.

If you need financial assistance, there are programs available to help with energy costs through HRDC and HCE Energy Assistance programs. More information can be found at www.hcelectric.com/my-account/energy-assistance

This decision was not made lightly by our Board of Trustees. We will continue to keep our cooperative cost as low as possible and will work to mitigate our raising cost of generated energy.

Important Information

It is time for members to consider running for the Hill County Electric Board of Trustees. District 1 is the district up for election this year.


Nominee requirements to run:

- Petition with district number and name of nominee
- Collect 15 current members' printed name, address and signature on petition
- Nominee must live within the district in which they are running
- · To sign the petition, a member does not have to live in the same district as the nominee
- Submit a signed petition to the cooperative no later than March 26th, 2025

After the petition is submitted, it will be reviewed for accuracy and if it passes the low threshold of 15 valid signatures, the name of the nominee will appear in the mail-in ballot, as well as on the ballot at the annual meeting for those who do not mail their ballot for the election of the Board of Trustees.

Keeping Pace with the Times:

Proposed Bylaw Changes for Hill County Electric

HCE is committed to providing affordable, reliable electrical services to its members. As the cooperative evolves to meet the changing needs of its members, it is crucial to review and update the bylaws to ensure they remain relevant, effective and meet the needs of today. The original bylaws were written over 80 years ago and many sections have remained the same. Below is a summary of the proposed changes that will be presented to our membership this spring:

Summary of proposed changes

Addressing Mail Delays

Recognizing the recent challenges with mail delivery and increased lead times for printing of the notice of members' meeting, the cooperative proposes extending the number of days before the meeting that the member will receive their notice of members' meeting. This extended amount of time will allow for the mail-in ballots to coincide with the mailing of the notice of members' meeting more closely.

Voting List

This requested bylaw change is a grammatic issue clean up that clarifies that the voting list is pulled for both the annual meeting and the mail-in/online voting.

Ensuring Trustees can be insured once elected

This proposed bylaw change would require all trustee candidates to undergo a felony conviction background check. This measure helps HCE obtain Director and Officer insurance coverage. The proposed bylaw changes are a testament to the cooperative's commitment to transparency, accountability, and continuous improvement. The bylaw changes will be published in the notice of the members' meeting for you to review in full. The cooperative encourages all members to review the proposed changes, and we respectively request that you accept these bylaw changes. Please watch for your mail-in ballot to arrive in April and come in person to the Annual Meeting on May 10, 2025. This year we will host the annual meeting at Hill County Electric in Building 8. We are excited to host our membership on the HCE campus.
